ST. FRANCIS COMMUNITY SERVICES (SFCS), an agency of Catholic Charities of St. Louis, seeks a Bilingual Therapist to provide counseling services to Spanish-speaking individuals. The position requires a Master's degree in Social Work, Counseling, Psychology, or a closely-related field.

In addition, candidate must have 2 years of experience in direct provision of mental health services (including internship) to English and/or Spanish speaking individuals and families. Candidate will have experience with refugees, immigrants, or individuals who have suffered trauma.

Other requirements include: Missouri license (full or provisional); driver's license and insurance, background checks; and a TB screening. Position requires commute to multiple parish locations in the St. Louis area.

St. Francis Community Services is one of the eight federated agencies of Catholic Charities of St. Louis. Our mission is to walk with vulnerable neighbors to create opportunities, to build resiliency, and to advocate for justice.
