



# SEEKING CCHD INTERN FOR 2021-2022

The St. Louis Archdiocese's Catholic Campaign for Human Development (CCHD) is seeking a Catholic committed to social justice for its 2021-2022 internship program. The intern will help carry out CCHD's mandate to address the root causes of poverty through transformative education and by funding efforts that help low-income people engage and overcome their circumstances with positive, permanent change.

Low-income people from diverse racial and ethnic backgrounds are especially encouraged to apply.

## **Skills**

Successful candidates will have excellent communication and organizational skills, a proficiency using social media, a strong understanding of Catholic social teaching, and experience/passion for working with low-income and/or marginalized people.

## **Responsibilities**

- Promote the annual CCHD parish collection
- Learn about CCHD-funded organizations
- Evaluate grant applications and make funding decisions as part of the CCHD committee
- Maintain website and social media channels
- Advance the CCHD art contest in area schools
- Build relationships with key parishes, clergy, and community leaders
- Reflect on Catholic social teaching

The internship is 14 hours/week for 24 weeks between September and May. Compensation is \$14/hour.

All 2021-2022 interns are required to attend **one** of the following virtual orientations: **May 26-28** and **August 4-6**.
